
Dear Parents/ Caregivers,


We would like to thank the parents and school community for their strength, resilience, and perseverance during Term 1 and for always supporting the school.



RAMADAN MUBARAK 1443

The month of Ramadan is an opportunity for the school to reinforce our Islamic faith and its teachings. Our students have learnt that the month of Ramadan is divided into three parts of ten days each. The first 10 days are for mercy, the second ten days are for forgiveness and the last 10 days are for freedom from the hell fire.

Students are challenged to take advantage of every second of Ramadan and to work towards seeking as much reward as possible. One of our students, Rythmica Ahmed in Year 6, created a poem about prayer times to share with our school community.



Prayer Times

Fajr begins when a streak of light appears Fajr ends when the sun interferes


Thuhr starts when your shadow is equal strap of your sandal This prayer ends when the shadow and object's length is equal

Our **Year 7 students created artworks** to display across the school to celebrate the holy month of Ramadan. There is a vibe of joy, tranquility, and happiness among the students as they observe Ramadan with open hearts and hands.

Our primary students started talking about Ramadan and its blessings the day before fasting started during their class picnics. Why do we need to experience hunger to get closer to Allah SWT? How can we help others who have no food to break their fast? How do we make sure everyone donates our recycled bottles and drink poppers to help the orphans and save the environment?



BOTTLE RECYCLING ORPHAN SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM

On day one of Ramadan 2021, one of our administration staff members, Mrs Amal Lazki set herself a mission to make a difference to the environment and help the less fortunate across the world. Mrs Lazki shared her mission with members of her family, friends, community, and colleagues and harnessed a force of good. Family, friends, neighbours, students, mothers, fathers, and teachers all started donating recycled bottles for this noble cause. Twelve months later and the day before Ramadan 2022 started, Mrs Lazki managed to inspire the community to donate 170,000 recycled bottles which raised \$17,000 for orphan sponsorship.



We would like to publicly celebrate Mrs Lazki's phenomenal achievement and acknowledge the time commitment of processing the collected bottles. May Allah SWT reward everyone involved for their efforts. Our environment and orphans are better because of this worthwhile initiative.







On Friday, 1st of April 2022, students from Kindergarten to Year 6 who contributed the largest number of bottles were invited to a pizza reward party where they reflected on how they have contributed to saving the environment, as well as helping the less fortunate.

At the end of every term, there will be more reward events for the students who continue to collect and donate recycled bottles for the Bottle Recycling & Orphan Sponsorship initiative.

Students in Years 5 and 6 participated in an integrated Islamic Studies and English task, where they created information cards that shared facts about Ramadan. The competition was very close, and all students


produced exceptionally creative cards that enhanced their knowledge of Ramadan.
